January 11, 2026

PRESENT: Derek Rand; Gabby Rognile; Laurie Dieken; Terry Noble; Lucas Doesken; Glen Miller; Cheryl Colby; Kat Schwitters (Treasurer) **ABSENT:** Randy Grussing **GUEST:** Lonnie Hanson from Cemetery Committee

Meeting Called to Order by Derek Rand.

Lonnie presented info on status of the columbarium. Bids for solar lighting near the building were requested with Meuller Electric taking the work. Lonnie also checked into having a stained-glass window placed. Cost is prohibitive at this time as concrete would need to be wet cut along with creation of the window and then installing the window. Request made for additional funds to work toward this goal as minimal burial plots have been purchased this year with costs for mowing and snow removal continuing. Motion made to place \$5000.00 into Cemetery Fund from Building Fund to replenish funds. Motion made by Gabby; seconded by Terry; motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Kat reviewed the 2025 Budget and Expenses. Other than the funds that had to be used for Pastor Joel's past benefits—the Church was approximately \$1100.00 over 2025 Budget. This is significant in how we have attempted to pare down expenses and how the congregation is demonstrating good stewardship and generous donations. . Kat has also completed updating Portico for salary and benefits for Pastor Joel for the 2026 year.

For Pastor Joel to complete his taxes the accountant needs to have Fair Market Value (FMV) for the parsonage completed for 2025 by the Council. Motion to identify a FMV of \$9000.00 for 2025. Motion made by Terry; seconded by Glen; motion carried.

Motion made by Laurie; seconded by Gabby to have Kat place \$60,000.00 into a 3-to-6-month CD, dependent on best interest rate and/or when funds may be needed. Motion carried.

Motion made by Gabby; seconded by Glen to accept the 2025 Budget and Expenses as well as the 2026 Budget to be presented at the Congregational Annual Meeting. Motion carried.

Motion made by Cheryl; seconded by Lucas to increase the mileage reimbursement rate to the Federal IRS 2026 rate of 72.5 cents per mile. Motion carried.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Report from the meeting of 12/12/2025 was reviewed. Motion made by Lucas; seconded by Terry; motion carried.

PASTOR'S REPORT: Very busy December with Christmas activities and services along with 56 pastoral visits. Will be on vacation from January 12th to the 17th. Pastoral coverage has been arranged.

OLD BUSINESS: Motion made by Gabby to have Noisy Offering for the first quarter to go to MACPAC Program. Seconded by Cheryl; motion carried.

Money Counters for **February** -Terry with new council member; **March**-Derek with new council member.

NEW BUSINESS: Derek will check with Kathy to identify members on various committees. He will check in with the Nominating Committee to identify their progress to identify people who agree to be on the slate for open positions for various vacancies. Thank you's received from Ridgewater Ministry and Food Shelf for donations.

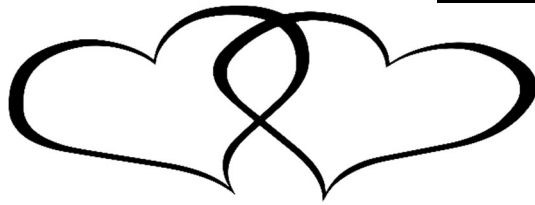
Open Radio Broadcasts for 2026
