

**IMMANUEL SPEAKS**

In St. Luke's telling of the Christmas story we hear these words spoken by an angel to the shepherds, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause you great joy for all people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born for you; he is the Messiah, the Lord" (Luke 2:10). Fear I think it is one of the constants of life. In fact, fear is so common that we hear the phrase "Do not be afraid" or one of its variants 119 times in Scripture. To put it simply, our world is filled with fear.

Now one of my favorite presidents FDR in his first inaugural address would share these words, "The only thing we have to fear is fear itself." I have to admit that while I understand what FDR was talking about, I find it very difficult to do. When we look at the world around us and see everything that happens there is a lot that we are or can be afraid of. There is sickness and death. There is violence, bloodshed, poverty, injustice, and war. There are broken relationships and broken families. There is the fear of being alone, or being unloved by others and by God. And the list of things we fear can go on and on.

In the end no matter how brave a front we put on, I think we all have fears and it is hard to overcome them. It is easy to let them dominate and control our lives. However, as we gather here during this advent and Christmas season, we hear these joyous words from the angelic host, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause you great joy for all people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born for you; he is the Messiah, the Lord."

The message from the angel is that fear will not dominate our lives. Fear will not have the final say or control our lives, for a Savior has been born for you. As our reading from the gospel of John will say on Christmas day, our savior, the Word of God, Jesus Christ became flesh and dwells among us. He comes to calm our fears and to wipe away our tears. Like a parent he comes to comfort us in his arms and reassure us of his everlasting love which is stronger than any fear the world can throw at us.

Amidst the fears of life, do not be afraid is the angel's message, for Christ has come to save you from sin, from death, and from all those things that seek to separate you from life with him both now and forever. My friends, this is the good news of the Christmas story. Our God is not a God who is far off. Rather our God is a God who loves us so much, that Jesus leaves the glory and splendor of heaven and enters our world as a one of us with a grace that is filled with the cosmic energy of God. Christ comes to us with a grace that is filled with the cosmic energy of God that seeks to reach into every corner of our lives and heal that which we find hardest to believe can be healed...to comfort that which we believe cannot be comforted...and to bring hope to those places within our soul that we imagine to be hopeless.

Sisters and brothers in Christ, as we enter into the joys and wonders of the Advent & Christmas season may the words of the angel give you great joy and quell your fears. "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born for you; he is the Messiah, the Lord." He is Immanuel, God with you, now and always!

**NOTES FROM THE CEMETERY COMMITTEE**

A new columbarium was purchased and installed in the vault building at the cemetery. The columbarium is a 78 double niche (meaning two urns per niche). The purchase price is \$47,672.00. We also have a bid of \$1,000.00 for solar lighting to be installed. We would like to add a window on the north side but the price was too costly at this time (a bid of \$12,000). The niche sizes are: 14" wide X 14" high X 23" deep. There is a 14" X 14" granite stone face.

Add the cost of opening/closing at \$150.00. More than two urns will be half of purchase price. Etching will be purchaser's cost.
